

Automating your Bulletin website access

You can avoid having to type your email address and password to access the Bulletin by changing your browser settings, as follows:

Explorer 6.x: On the top menu, pick Tools then Internet Options and click on the Content tab, then click the AutoComplete button. Make sure there is a check mark beside "User names and passwords on forms" and beside "Prompt me to save passwords" then click OK. If you have already accessed the Bulletin before doing this, close and restart it. After you access the Bulletin again "manually" one more time, in future you should see something like this:

Click on the address, and your password should be filled in automatically, showing as a series of dots.

Firefox 1.x: On the top menu, pick Tools then Options and click the Privacy (padlock) icon. Make sure there is a check mark beside "Remember passwords" then click OK. The next time you enter your email address and password to access the Bulletin, you should see this box, click Remember, and both username and password should appear automatically in future.
